

Target Sports Range and Match Rules

In order to host IPSC matches at Target Sports, we are required to comply with a set of rules. Please see below.

1. **Picture ID and a Waiver Form**

If you are not a member of Target Sports, you must present your picture ID and a Waiver Form when you arrive at the range. Driver's licence would work best and you can save yourself some time by downloading the Waiver Form from our website at <https://www.ipscleague.ca>. Simply fill it out, print the form and bring it with you.

2. **Range Address**

The address of the range is 14 Stalwart Industrial Drive Gormley, ON, L0H 1G0
GPS coordinates: 43.94543184771129, -79.37300255647614

3. **Parking**

Parking lot is always busy, so give yourself enough time to find a spot. Make sure not to park on the street where no-parking signs are installed. Gormley Industrial Ave. has a section without no-parking signs, so as the last resort, you can use this section of the street.

4. **Upon arrival at Target Sports**

- Members of Target Sports, please proceed to Classroom B.
- Non-Members of Target Sports, please wait for the entrance door to be opened by the staff member and then proceed to Classroom B.

5. **Getting Ready**

- With the exception of the firearm, you can get all other gear ready in the Classroom B.
- You can uncase the firearm only inside Range B, at the safety table.
- Safety table area is clearly marked. Please do not step away from the marked area with a firearm in hand. This will prevent the risk of disqualification for unsafe handling of the firearm.
- No firearms are permitted outside of the range. If you need to take a break, please leave your firearm on the safety table inside the range.

6. **Probationary IPSC Members**

Probationary IPSC members must notify RO upon arrival at the range.

7. **Safety Line**

During an active stage all competitors must stay behind a safety line. Only RO's and Scorekeepers are allowed to remain beyond the safety line.

8. Warning: Any shot that hits the range concrete walls, floor or ceiling will be treated as unsafe and result in club (not IPSC) disqualification.

9. **Range floor**

Concrete floor may get slippery from time to time. Please manage your speed according to the conditions.

10. **Use of Yellow Caution Tape**

Yellow caution tape = a solid wall from floor to ceiling. Do not shoot targets across the yellow tape, as this will count as a mike.

11. Keeping Peace

- Verbal altercations while in the Range B are prohibited.
- Physical altercations are prohibited regardless of where you are on the property.
- Range Officer is the only authority during the match and while in the range. Obeying commands is mandatory.
- If for any reason you disagree with the RO or anyone else about anything, you must:
 - make sure that you have no firearms in your hands
 - whenever possible place your firearm on the safety table and ask the RO (or another party) to join you outside of the range
 - ask to have senior RO to join you, if necessary
 - resolve your concerns in a peaceful manner

Violations will result in disqualification.
